Steps to Graduate

Submit an Official Degree Plan.

- Meet with your advisor and submit an official degree plan no later than the end of the sophomore year (60 credit hours).

Fulfill degree requirements.

- The degree plan becomes official when all appropriate signatures have been obtained. Thereafter, the student bears ultimate responsibility for fulfilling degree requirements for graduation.

Fill out an Application to Graduate form.

- Applications are available on the DBU website (download and print from www.dbu.edu/registrar), at DBU Hurst-Colleyville, DBU North, and on the main campus at the Registrar's Office.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Early Applications (\$25.00) ends:

- June 5, 2017, for December 2017 graduation
- November 6, 2017, for May 2018 graduation
- April 5, 2018, for August 2018 graduation

Regular Applications (\$100.00) ends:

- November 16, 2017, for December 2017 graduation
- April 13, 2018, for May 2018 graduation
- July 6, 2018, for August 2018 graduation

Late Applications (\$200.00) begins:

- November 17, 2017, for December 2017 graduation
- April 16, 2018, for May 2018 graduation
- July 9, 2018, for August 2018 graduation
