

Dear DBU Family-

As summer begins and we continue moving toward normal operations, DBU is required to send an Emergency Notification* under the **Clery Act** to all students and employees to ensure you are informed about COVID-19.

The University provides an update on confirmed positive cases among DBU faculty, staff, or students upon request. Additionally, DBU is requiring face coverings in the classroom through June 30, 2021, and face coverings are optional everywhere else. Starting July 1, 2021, face coverings will additionally be optional in the classroom.

The University continues to offer vaccines on campus. If you are interested in receiving the vaccine, please contact Health Services.

If you are a DBU student or employee and experiencing any of the **COVID-19 symptoms** or you are a close contact of someone who has tested positive for the virus, please continue to report to DBU at www.dbu.edu/coronavirus. For the summer, DBU also requires all faculty, staff, and students to complete a daily health survey at www.dbu.edu/healthcheck.
