MUSIC MAJOR SCHOLARSHIP ENSEMBLE REQUIREMENTS 2025-2026

Note: These requirements are in addition to degree/catalog requirements

Piano Principals

• 2 Ensembles Required for other Piano Principals from any combination of ensembles offered in the Department

Other Instrumental Principals (2 Ensembles Required)

- First ensemble must audition and if selected perform with one of the following ensembles: Guitar Ensemble, Rock Band, Jazz If not selected, student may choose from any instrumental or vocal ensemble.
- Second Ensemble chosen from any instrumental or vocal ensemble.

Voice Principals (2 Ensembles Required)

- First ensemble Patriot Chorus OR Liberty Chorus
- Must complete annual audition as well as the call back process and if selected sing in the DBU Chorale

General Considerations

- In all ensemble assignments, care will be taken not to disrupt or hinder the recipient's academic schedule.
- Students must be registered for the appropriate ensemble(s) as quickly as possible prior to the start of each semester but no later than the Add/Drop date to avoid losing their scholarships.
- Zero credit ensembles courses meet ensemble **scholarship** requirements.
- Students must be enrolled in the ensemble the full academic year (unless they are student teaching or graduating) so long as the ensemble course is offered; if an ensemble is only offered for one semester the student must enroll in another ensemble for the other semester of the academic year.
- Students wanting to be considered to change their principal instrument must complete an audition for the full Music Faculty. They sign up to audition at www.dbu.edu/audition. Changes to principal instruments will impact Applied Lesson requirements/options. Scholarship amounts are not guaranteed for new principal instrument assignments.
- Exceptions may be requested by email to Dr. Joshua Brown Chair of Ensembles. Any approved exceptions will need approval from the Chair of Ensembles and Chair of the Department of Music and Dean

Merit-Based Music Scholarship Increases

- Scholarship increases are subject to all of the guidelines stipulated within the music scholarship contract for the student's original music scholarship offer/award.
- Music Majors receiving a music scholarship will be considered by the Music Faculty for merit-based scholarship increases at least once per academic year to go into effect the next long semester.
- The increase will be one year in duration and will stack with their current contracted music scholarship. Students will be eligible to be considered (but not guaranteed) for future increases.
- Students not on music scholarship must complete the audition process to be considered for a scholarship and are not eligible for increases outside of the audition process.

NON-MUSIC MAJOR SCHOLARSHIP ENSEMBLE REQUIREMENTS 2025-2026

Important Considerations

- A limited number of Non-Music Major Scholarships are available to students who participate in ensembles at DBU.
- Students must be registered for the appropriate ensemble(s) as quickly as possible prior to the start of each semester but no later than the Add/Drop date to gain any offered scholarships. The student on scholarship must have a passing grade in the ensemble course to maintain their scholarship.
- Zero credit ensembles courses meet ensemble **scholarship** requirements.
- A student may gain scholarship(s) for no more than two ensembles per semester.
- Scholarships are made based on competitive audition and require the recommendation of the ensemble director(s).

They are only offered on a semester-by-semester basis as needed for specific ensembles and are not guaranteed through the student's course of study.
