Study Abroad Eligibility Policy

Students wishing to participate in a DBU Study Abroad/Study Away program must meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Must have completed at least 12 credit hours at DBU prior to the beginning of the study abroad/study away program start date.
- 2. Must not be a senior who will be graduating in the semester of their chosen study abroad/study away program, unless receiving special approval from the Dean of Global Studies.
- 3. A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher by the date of application is strongly preferred by the Global Studies Office.
- 4. Must be in good disciplinary standing with the University.
- 5. Must be in good financial standing with the University.
- 6. Must receive a recommendation from at least one DBU full-time or adjunct faculty member.
- 7. Must meet with their academic advisor to confirm that their chosen study abroad/study away program will fit into their degree plan (or that they understand the academic and financial consequences of choosing to engage in a program that will not fit into their degree plan).
- 8. International students must have approval from the International Admissions and Immigration Office to indicate they are eligible to travel and understand the implications for their visa status.
- 9. International students must have approval from the International Admissions and Immigration Office to indicate they are eligible to travel and understand the implications for their visa status.
- 10. Students in the Intensive English Program are not eligible to participate in study abroad programs until they have completed their IEP program and have become a full-time academic student.
- 11. Must take at least one course during their chosen study abroad/study away program, unless receiving special approval from the Dean of Global Studies due to extenuating circumstances.
- 12. Must agree to abide by the DBU Student Handbook while engaging in the program.
- 13. Must agree to abide by the rules found in the DBU Study Abroad Field Guide while engaging in the program.
- 14. Must agree to abide by any program-specific rules given to the student at the start of the program.
- 15. Must provide a record proving that they have received all immunizations that are required by the Global Studies Office for the country where they will be living as a part of their program.
- 16. Must agree to pay all amounts due as of the date indicated on the program-specific Travel Intent Form, understanding that DBU will bill the student's account if payment is not received by those indicated dates.

Participants will be chosen for each program based on a range of factors, including, but not limited to: a) the priority date of their application; b) the recommendation letter from the DBU faculty member; c) the student's academic record; d) the student's disciplinary and financial record; e) the student's moral fitness

and ability to represent the University well; f) the limited number of same-sex rooms available at each program location; g) language ability and cross-cultural experience; h) other program-specific factors.
