

# **Proof Of Funds**

An international student who wishes to study inside the US on an F-1 visa will be required to prove that they have the funds available to support them for the first academic year of their studies. Once they provide this evidence, the DSOs will provide an I-20 for that student.

At Dallas Baptist University, if a student's first semester will be either Fall or Spring, here is the funding they would have to prove:
