

Buildings within the Global Village


Located on the southeastern section of the campus, the Global Village is comprised of four main buildings, overlooking the Bush Park and Mike Arnold Fitness Trail.

The newest of these buildings is the Jeannette and Cletys Sadler Global Missions Center, which houses the International Admissions Department, the Student Affairs and Spiritual Life offices, the Baptist Student Ministry offices, and the offices for the M.A. in Global Leadership program.


Next to the Sadler Global Missions Center is the David and In Sun Moon International Center, housing the International
