In a recent update to the \$100 million prayer partners, Dr. Cook shared how this campaign is touching lives far beyond DBU. Below is an excerpt from his message:

Dear Prayer Partners:

I wanted to tell you that I had not thought about how this DBU prayer campaign might be helpful to others outside of DBU in the Lord's work. However, I wanted to share with you this wonderful story.

James Byun just graduated with his Ph.D. from DBU. When he started the doctoral work, he was a minister here in Dallas, then he became a minister in Washington D.C., and after he finished all of his course work, he actually moved to South Korea to begin a new church there.

James' parents were from South Korea, but James only lived there until he was two, and then his parents brought him to the United States where he grew up in California. He felt called to go back to his home country to share the Gospel with them and begin a church that is already flourishing.

Now, here is more good news. He just officially decided to begin an intercessory prayer ministry at his church. I was just thrilled to hear this. Isn't this wonderful that James has begun an intercessory prayer ministry at his church as a result of our prayer emphasis here at DBU? So, this prayer campaign for \$100 million is actually more than just about raising this amount of money for scholarships. It is about Kingdom work for the Lord Jesus.

I also wanted to let you know that we started a formal Intercessory Prayer Ministry, much like you have at DBU (see pictures attached).
